

Activity for 'Just Like Mommy' by Sharon Harmer



This book introduces many different animals and the noises they make. Have fun trying to recreate some the animal sounds !

Can you clip clop and whinney like a horse ?

Can you baa and bleat like a sheep ?

Can you moo like a cow ?

Can you hoot like an owl ?

Can you woof like a dog ?

What other animals can you think of ? What noises do they make ?

While you are practicing your animal sounds, it would be a great time to sing the popular song Old MacDonald ! Have fun experimenting with different animals and use your imagination - who says there were no dinosaurs at Old MacDonalds farm ?! If you are in a group, let each child choose an animal for the group to sing.

What you will need :

- 3 sheets of cardstock in colours of your choice
- Markers or crayons
- Stickers or any decorations of your choice
- Scissors (and adult supervision)
- Glue


Step 1

Using the colours you have chosen for the wings of your butterfly, draw around your hand twice on each colour, to give you four handprints. Cut out.



Step 2

Cut out an oblong shape for the body of the butterfly from the colour of your choice. Cut two thin strips and glue to the top as antennae. Use a marker to draw a smiley face.



Step 3

Using one of each colour on each side, glue your butterfly wings to the side of your butterfly's body.



You can use stickers, glitter, crayons, markers or whatever you choose to decorate your butterfly's wings.

Give as a special keepsake to mommy, grandma or another special person in your life !
