



Pig the Stinker

Suggested activity:

Stinky Pig the Pug craft

Materials Required:

- Paper plate
- Brown paint
- Brown and black paper or cardstock
- Marker pens
- Plastic eyes
- Black pom pom, or button
- Glue
- A plastic cup, to draw around



After reading the story, invite the children to make their very own Pig the Stinker!

- Begin by drawing around a paper cup onto a brown piece of paper. Cut out and stick in the centre of your paper plate.
- Stick the black pom pom or button onto the top centre of the brown circle. This will be Pig the Stinker's nose.
- With a black marker or crayon, draw a mouth shape underneath the nose.
- Glue two plastic eyes above the brown circle.
- Cut out two large, droopy ear shapes from black or brown paper and glue them to the side of the head. (For younger children, you may want to pre-cut the ears, or make an outline they can cut around).
- Using brown paint, let the children use their fingers to dab blobs of 'dirt' onto their pig. They get to choose just how dirty they make him!
- You could even glue a craft stick to the bottom of the paper plate and use it as a mask!
